Message From The President

Whether you are an owner, operator or manufacturer, safety has always been a top priority for people involved in the construction and mining industry. I recently had a chance to view a presentation by the folks at Caterpillar's Customer Safety Services. They are justifiably proud of Caterpillar's safety efforts and a big part of their mission is to share their knowledge with everyone – check out some of their work at cat.safety.com. When I was an 18 year-old laborer in a welding shop, it was not "cool" to wear safety gear such as safety glasses or hard hats – until you got injured and formed a new, improved, opinion. So I am glad to see Caterpillar make this effort.

While we may not be as adept as Cat at marketing our safety efforts outside of our company, safety is a big part of Mega's business as well. With about 150 employees and a product line that includes objects weighing up to 75 tons we have to be. Internally, we have a Safety Committee that has the responsibility to do whatever it takes to make our operation safe and the authority to go with it. The latest addition to our arsenal of safety equipment is a defibrillator and about half of our employees are trained to use it. For our customers, we are in the process of developing new operator's, maintenance and service manuals for all of our products – many are already in publication. These new manuals are tremendously better than what we offered in the past – knowing how to use and maintain our products is one step in their safe operation.

I want to remind all of our customers and employees that the best safety tool can be found between your ears – i.e. your brain. No matter how many classes you attend or what latest safety gear you acquire, it is of no use if you aren't actively thinking about safety when you are on the job. If you are around the manufacture or use of heavy equipment, you need to be aware of how things can go wrong and have a plan in mind for how to react. The Boy Scouts have a motto – "Be Prepared" - I think it applies to our business as well.

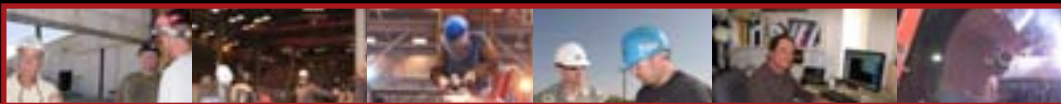

Large truck-based tanks and other mining products have replaced much of the smaller construction equipment in our shop. While we remain very busy, this change left portions of our shop available for fabrication of smaller weldments – the areas that were not suited to building the big stuff.

As luck would have it, New Mexico has become a magnet for solar power generation equipment manufacturers including Emcore Corporation (emcore.com). Emcore approached us about one year ago about the possibility of manufacturing the pedestal base and frame for their solar panels. As you can see from the accompanying photo, these panels are about the size of a billboard and provide utility-scale power generation – about 25kW each.

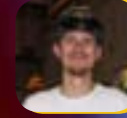

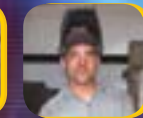
