With Thanksgiving and Christmas just around the corner, 2008 is nearing completion. 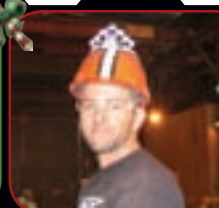
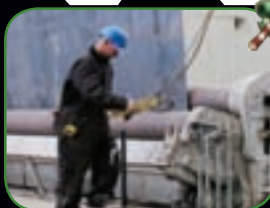
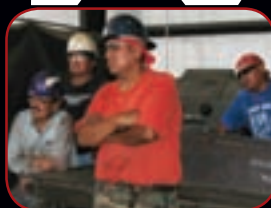
### Maintenance Supervisor

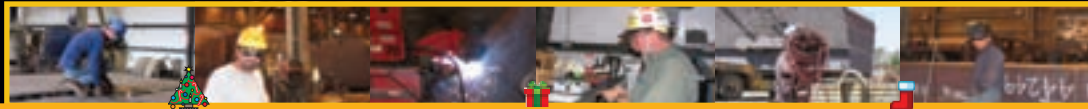
## MEGA WELDER BECOMES U.S CITIZEN
